

Household Hazardous Waste Drop Off Event

October 14, 2023

**Location: Warman Fire Hall
501 Centennial Blvd**



To help you dispose of household hazardous waste, the City has coordinated a Household Hazardous Waste Day. On October 14, 2023, a temporary site will be set up at the Warman Fire Hall parking lot (501 Centennial Blvd) from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. for residents of Warman to drop off their household hazardous waste materials for recycling or safe disposal.

Program Reminders:

This event is for Warman residents only and ID is required to prove Warman residency at the gate. **We do not accept waste from businesses, institutions, or RM residents.**

Please remain in your vehicle. HHW material should be safely sealed in clearly marked containers and placed in the back of your vehicle.

Maximum 60 L of used oil per vehicle will be accepted. Excess oil (up to 500 L) can be taken to the Eco Centre at the Saskatoon Landfill. Visit saskatoon.ca for more info.

Bring fuel and oil in containers that may be left behind for recycling/disposal.

Propane cylinders will no longer be accepted. They can instead be recycled through FCL. Please drop off at the Co-op gas bar, 35 – 810 Centennial Blvd.

Household Paint will no longer be accepted. It can instead be recycled at Sarcan, 1210 Boucher Ave.

Electronics will no longer be accepted. They can instead be recycled at Sarcan, 1210 Boucher Ave.

**The City of Warman reserves the right to refuse any material, item, or quantity at our discretion.*

Residential Organics Waste Depot

This depot is for the collection of **RESIDENTIAL** organics – grass clippings, leaves and small tree trimmings. **The bins are located on the east side of Diamond Arena parking lot – 2 Pacific Avenue** and are available May 1 to November 5.

Pumpkins will be accepted from October 31 to November 5.

These green bins are for organics **ONLY**, no plastic bags will be allowed in the bin. A separate red bin will be on site for the disposal of your plastic bags after emptying them into the green bin.

An option for curbside organic pick up is available for \$10.00 a month from May 1 – Oct 26. Please call City Hall at 306-933-2133 to inquire about subscribing.

Please DO NOT drop any food waste or other waste into the green bins. Food waste will attract flies and cause foul odours. This excludes pumpkins from Oct 31 – Nov 5.

Please empty your compost items inside the bins. DO NOT THROW ITEMS ON THE GROUND OUTSIDE THE BINS.

THESE BINS ARE NOT FOR GARBAGE.

Misuse of this depot will result in fines to offenders and the removal of this service.

Annual Fall Cleanup 2023

***** Please follow guidelines to avoid items not being picked up. *****

South Side of Central Street
ALL items MUST be out by 7:00 AM Sept 18th
Pick up: Sept 18 to Sept 20

North of Central **and West** of Centennial
(Including Centennial)
ALL items MUST be out by 7:00 AM Sept 21st
Pick up: Sept 21 to Sept 25

North of Central **and East** of Centennial
ALL items MUST be out by 7:00 AM Sept 26th
Pick up: Sept 26 to Sept 28

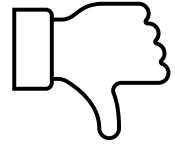
- All **acceptable** items left in the alley, on the dates mentioned, will be hauled away for you by our Public Works Department.
- Items must be ready for pickup at **7:00 am** in the back alley on the **first day** shown for your area. Public Works will not go back to pick up items put out after this time.
- Items must be bundled and packaged neatly (bagged or boxed) for quick and efficient pick-up.
- Please separate metal materials from the rest of the garbage, as they will be picked up separately.
- Items must be completely in the alley and off the property, but not hinder back alley traffic. If there is any confusion items will **NOT** be picked up.

Do not place items in your alley prior to one week before we begin City Cleanup. PROPERTIES DOING SO WILL BE SUBJECT TO BYLAW ENFORCEMENT.

- Please **DO NOT** leave any items in the alley that you do not want picked up.
- The City will not be responsible for any items picked up in error.
- Residents with no back alley will have items picked up on the first day of the cleanup for their area. Please have your items ready by 7:00 am at the end of your driveway.
- Leaves, garden refuse and grass clippings **must** be bagged. (The Compost Depot is a better option).
- Tree branches must be **cut in lengths no longer than four feet and tied**. (The compost depot is a better option).
- Carpet must be rolled and **cut to no longer than four feet in length**.
- **Appliances** - the City will not accept multiples of each per home.
- **Limit - TWO CUBIC YARDS per household.**
- **City cleanup is for residential homes only. The City will not pick up items from businesses or institutions.**
- **Items remaining in the alley after City Cleanup are the responsibility of the homeowner to cleanup.**
- **Failure to remove items remaining in the alley after City Cleanup is over will result in the resident being charged a fine of \$200. (Bylaw 2006-01)**

Items That WILL NOT Be Picked Up:

- **Materials from major renovations**
- **Drywall**
- **Deck boards**
- **Shingles**
- **Railroad ties**
- **Power poles**
- **Sod**
- **Tires** (take to HHWD on October 14)
- **Concrete and rocks**
- **Tree trunks and logs**
- **Day to day household garbage**
- **Motor oil** (this can be taken to HHWD on October 14, limit of 60 L)
- **Toxic materials such as chemicals, gasoline, etc.** (this can be taken to HHWD on October 14)
- **Household Paint** (take to SARCAN)
- **Batteries** (take to SARCAN or HHWD October 14)
- **Leaves and grass not in bags** (can be taken to compost bins)
- **Small Branches not bundled and tied** (can be taken to compost bins)
- **LIMIT OF TWO CUBIC YARDS PER ADDRESS**
