


WHERE TO SHOP



Whether you are visiting Warman, or are a long-time resident, our retailers welcome you! You'll find Warman has three distinct shopping areas, each with a unique variety of stores that are worth spending the time to discover great finds. Enjoy exploring each of these areas and use the maps on the following pages to help you navigate Warman's vibrant shopping and dining experiences.

► Central

The Central shopping district is the heart of Warman, and the city's original core. Starting on the east end of Central Street, the first shopping opportunity is the mall at 110 Central Street East with home decor options such as Decor-X, as well as White Cat Stationery and Gift Shop, plus costumes and more. One block west is Diamond Centre Pharmacy with a large selection of giftware, and family fashions across the street at Clothing Obsession. There are three thrift stores in this area (Warman Thrift Shop, I-Deal to You and Dreamers), as well as several specialty shops located along Central Street including Warman's original mall, Warman Plaza, at 520 Central Street West, with stores specializing in toys and gifts and women's fashions.

► Legends

The Legends area of Warman's north side is booming with unique, locally-owned shops, pharmacies, grocery stores, restaurants and several dollar stores. Head south into Warman on Centennial Avenue from Highway 305 and you'll see Zak's Home Hardware, Buy Low Foods and Dollarama at 930 Centennial. Giftware, liquor and the fashions of KHL Clothing Store make it worth the stop at 910 Centennial, as well as 900 Centennial, which offers handcrafted goods, groceries and Bodacious Bustlines Bras and Lingerie. The Legends Plaza at 810 Centennial boasts a wide array of stores and services including Legends Pharmacy, pet supplies, electronics, and much more. Next is the newest retail centre at 825 Centennial featuring Pretty Little Pieces, The High Maintenance Hippie and Dice Hollow Games. Warman Co-op and Shopper's Drug Mart are nearby, as well as Top Shelf Sports (seasonal), along with dining and service options, in the Warman Home Centre Communiplex

► South

Don't overlook Warman's expansive south side which has several areas with shopping 'must-stops.' Warman Home Centre on South Railway Street is the furthest west, with several retail centres south of there on Boehr Avenue and Industrial Road, where you'll find Atlas Outdoors Cycle and Recreation. Head further south on Industrial Road or 6th Avenue South to Steves Street, where you'll find specialty shops featuring goods such as jewelry, flowers, furniture, health and beauty items, liquidation (Carpe Diem Creations) and even cabinetry from H & T Cabinets.

Even though you can find virtually everything right here in Warman, we love our neighbours! It's a quick drive to Martensville to check out the locally-owned Canadian Tire store.

Shopping in Warman is a great way to stock up on your favourite things, find new fashions or pick up a few gifts. Enjoy the welcoming and friendly atmosphere of our locally owned stores.


Ditch the big city retailers and SHOP LOCAL.
