Public Service Announcement: Micro Surfacing

The City of Warman will be doing micro surfacing on our paved roads starting the week of July 2nd and running until July 31st (weather permitting). Work will be happening as far north as **Wilken Crescent** to as far south as **Haichert Street**. The project will also be expanded as far west as **Biliske Drive** and east as **400 Block 4st East**. We want to remind residents that at this time, the work will not be happening all at once. **This project will occur on three to five streets at a time every day, including weekends.** Signs will be posted along the roads, notifying residents that work will commence. The work will take up to a day to complete before residents will be allowed to drive or park on the streets.

The City of Warman will update which roads will be affected daily on our social media channels and website.



The roads marked in black on the map (see above) indicate where the micro surfacing will be happening.

About the project:

Micro Surfacing is a preservation project that helps prolong the life of roadways. The treatment seals the surface and provides a new wearing surface. This will rejuvenate over 17% of the roadways in the City of Warman.
